

Terms & Conditions

By entering this Competition, entrants are deemed to have read, understood, and accepted the following terms and conditions:

A. Competition

- This competition is for the Vector Lights for BNZ Auckland Diwali Festival competition ("the Competition"). The promoters are Tātaki Auckland Unlimited ("the Promoters").
- 2. To be eligible, entrants must fall into one of the following categories:
 - i. Group A: Storyboard Entry
 - ii. Group B: Drawing Entry
- To enter the Competition, you must submit your storyboard or drawing entry via the Diwali website at www.aucklandnz.com/diwali. Only one Competition Entry per entrant.
- 4. The Competition commences on Friday 2 August 2024 at 12pm and closes on Sunday 1 September 2024 at 5pm.
- 5. By entering this Competition, you agree that the Promoters may display your Competition Entry online at www.aucklandnz.com/diwali, on the Promoters' websites, news, and social media sites. Entries may also be displayed in news media to promote the Competition.
- 6. You will retain ownership of the Competition Entry, but agree to grant to the Promoters a worldwide, exclusive, and royalty-free license to use, reproduce, and otherwise utilise the Competition Entry for promotional purposes.

7. You warrant that:
